

Ship News.



On Tuesday evening the pleasant information was received of the safe arrival of the ship Archduke Charles, Captain Jeffries, in Botany Bay, from whence Despatches were forwarded to His EXCELLENCY the GOVERNOR over-land. This vessel, which, as our former reports stated, had left Rio Janeiro in company with the Minstrel, was obliged to put into the Cape of Good Hope, from whence she sailed for this Port the beginning of October, on the first day of which month a vessel had arrived with dispatches which announced the gratifying intelligence we have the happiness to communicate in our subsequent Columns.

Sailed on Wednesday the ship Frederick, Captain Davison, for Hobart Town, and from thence to Bengal. Lieutenant Governor DAVY publicly embarked on Monday, and was saluted from Dawes's Point with 13 guns. Mrs. and Miss DAVY went on board at daylight on Wednesday morning, as did also Lieutenant LAURENCE, Assistant Surgeon DANKORR, of the 73d Regiment, and J. P. BELL, Esq. who intends returning hither from Hobart Town by the first opportunity that offers.
