

## Answers Bring More Questions.

- What was the *business* which Isaac carried-on for *several years* prior ?
- What was his motive for robbery at the bank ?
- Why didn't Redmond indict Isaac *capitally* for robbery ?
- Why was there no prosecution of Isaac in August 1811 ?
- Where, & how, did Isaac afford the then massive sum of £1,000 "Good-Behaviour" Bond to be paid in August 1811, if he was driven to robbery just 15 months earlier ?
- What relationship was *Archibald WOOD*, indicted at the same time, & what part if any, did his stealing of 4 keys from John Redmond, play in the Redmond Bank robbery ?
- Why was Isaac indicted & tried for the bank-robbery, in May 1812 after not being indicted in August 1811 ?
- Was there animosity between Isaac, & the Redmond brothers ?
  - Why do the accounts of the robbery conflict ; the 1810 report saying he concealed inside the bank's premises until long after closing-time, the 1812 evidence saying he *entered inside just as the doors were shutting in the evening*, as witnessed by several at the time, who *knew him intimately* ?
  - *Archibald WOOD* was transported to Botany Bay aboard the same ship as Isaac, ("*Archduke Charles*"), leaving Cove, Ireland, in mid-May 1812. He appears to have married a Mary White in Sydney-Town in 1817. After that, no record is found of him. What became of him ?
